# From Pastor Ryan...

"It is the Lord who goes before you. He will be with you; He will not leave you or forsake you. Do not fear or be dismayed" (Deuteronomy 31:8).

Change is hard. As much as we say that we - as human beings - like spontaneity and randomness, we are actually geared, hard-wired, for structure and for continuity. Over the years, studies have consistently proven that building routine and structure into our daily life is one of the healthiest things that we can do for ourselves. Children, in particular, respond very well to an organized, structured (yet flexible!) routine. Whether we are adults or children, routines and habits give us a foundation to build the rest of our day - and, ultimately, the rest of our lives - upon.

But every once in a while, something happens that completely throws us off of our normal routine and the structure that we've set in place. No, I'm not talking about the one time last week that you overslept and woke up late for work; I'm talking about the big things you can't see coming. It's the 67 MPH curveball down-and-away, when you were looking for a fastball, high-and-tight in the strike zone. Maybe for you it was coming in for work one morning, only to discover that you had been let go. Maybe it was the sudden, unexpected death of a loved one. Maybe it involved changing schools and having to meet new people. Not all change, however, is negative. A new career. A chance to travel overseas. An old friendship that gets rekindled.

For me, the change that I didn't see coming was a positive change.

When I first was contacted by the call committee about the possibility of joining the staff here at Maranatha, I balked. I thought to myself (and probably out loud to my wife), "No way." I gave the polite answer of "I'll pray about it and get back to you in two weeks." However, the more I prayed about it, the more I felt the Lord's leading and guiding in this direction. One of the verses of Scripture that He used to direct me as I was praying was a statement that Moses said to Joshua as Joshua was about to succeed him as leader of the Israelites. Moses reminded Joshua: "It is the Lord who goes before you. He will be with you; He will not leave you or forsake you. Do not fear or be dismayed." (Deuteronomy 31:8) So important was this reminder of the Lord's continued presence for Joshua, that Moses had to repeat it twice - once in 31:6 and then in 31:8! And even after Moses' death, Joshua needed to be reminded again of the promise of the Lord's presence - this time from the Lord Himself! (Joshua 1:5, 9)

The Lord used these verses to remind me of His continued presence with me - even in the midst of the changes that were coming. That's not to say the change has been easy. It has been hard to uproot my family from Arizona, the only home my children have known, and move to Minnesota. It was hard leaving the friendships and the relationships that we had cultivated during our time there.

The change has been hard, but it has also been good. As a family, we are slowly adjusting to our new routines and putting some structure back into our lives after being uprooted and replanted. As a pastor, I'm settling into the role of Associate and learning work with a team; instead of the lone-ranger attitude that often accompanies missionaries, even home missionaries.

I want to thank you, as a congregation, for helping us make our transition to Maranatha as smooth as possible. You have made us feel very welcome here. We already feel right at home. We appreciate you very much and we look forward to getting to know each of you.
